

BOLOGNA AIRPORT: OVER 700 THOUSAND PASSENGERS IN AUGUST (+2,1%)

A total of over 4,5 million passengers from the beginning of the year (+2,4%)

New record numbers at Bologna Airport: over 700 thousand passengers in August (704.840, +2,1% vs August 2014), a result accounting for the best month in the history of the Airport.

International passengers were 545.405 (+4,7%), domestic passengers totaled 159.435 (-5,8%). On the whole, international passengers accounted for 77,4% of all August passengers.

Here are the hit destinations in August: three capital cities London, Paris, Barcelona are the favorite ones, followed by Frankfurt, Catania, Palermo, Casablanca, Madrid, Istanbul and Amsterdam among scheduled connections.

As regards charter destinations, Greek and Spanish islands are the most popular: Ibiza, Palm of Maiorca, Rhodes, Tenerife, Mahon, Santorini and Kos are in the top ten.

In the first eight months of the year, passengers have totaled 4.565.057, with a growth of 2,4% versus the same period of 2014.

If Summer at Bologna Airport is closing with excellent numbers, Autumn is announcing important news: from 25th October, Aeroflot will be operating the second daily flight to Moscow on Wednesdays, Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays.
